IMPLEMENTATION OF THE THREE-LANGUAGE POLICY FOR CLASS IX (SESSION 2026-27)

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

In accordance with the press release and guidelines issued by CBSE on **2nd June, 2026** regarding the implementation of the revised Three-Language Policy, we wish to inform you that the current batch of Class IX (2026-27) students will continue with the languages already chosen at the time of admission, with the addition of one more Indian language as mandated under the revised Scheme of Studies.

The language structure at St Vivekanand Public School, Sadabad will be as follows:

- English (Medium of Instruction) will be offered as **R1 (First Language)**.
- Students who have opted for Hindi as R2 (Second Language) will study Sanskrit as **R3 (Third Language)**.

Important Points for Class IX

1. **Assessment:** The Third Language (R3) will be assessed by the school through an Internal School-Based Assessment only.
2. **Board Examination:** There will be no CBSE Board Examination for the Third Language (R3) when this batch appears for the Class X Board Examination in the academic session 2027-28.
3. **Children with Special Needs (CwSN):** Relaxation and exemptions from the compulsory Third Language requirement will be provided in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016.

This circular is issued for the information of all parents of Class IX. We request your cooperation in the smooth implementation of the revised Three-Language Policy.
